This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act request received May 30, 2014. This request was forwarded from our DOE Headquarters Office. You requested a copy of all communication between the U.S. Department of Energy and Clean Line Energy relating to the 2000' corridor maps of the proposed Clean Line Energy Plains and Eastern transmission line.

Your request was assigned to the Office of Corporate Operations to conduct a search of its files for responsive records.

A reasonable search was performed and Southwestern found no responsive documents.

This decision as well as the adequacy of the search, may be appealed within 30 calendar days from your receipt of this letter pursuant to 10 C.F.R. Part 1004.8. Appeals should be addressed to Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, HG-1, L'Enfant Plaza, U.S. Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20585-1614. The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA appeal is being made. The appeal must contain all the elements required by 10 C.F.R. 1004.8, including a copy of the determination letter. Thereafter, judicial review will be available to you in the Federal District Court either (1) in the district where you reside, (2) where you have your principal place of business, (3) where DOE's records are situated, or (4) in the District of Columbia.
