This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act email request dated January 9, 2010, and received the same date. We agreed upon an extension until February 24, 2010. In your email you requested: Statistical information for SWPA competitive service employees performance ratings under 2.0 for organizations 6100, 6200, and 6300, over the age of 40 and under the age of 40. You also requested the average performance ratings for FY2008 and FY2009 and the average age of non-supervisory Federal employees in the Division of Human Resources.

In response to your request for statistical information for SWPA competitive service employee performance rating under 2.0 for organizations 6100, 6200, and 6300, we have performed a reasonable search and found no documents.

Also, a reasonable search was performed and no documents were found which show the average performance ratings for FY2008 and FY2009 nor the average age of non-supervisory Federal employees in the Division of Human Resources.
